Cat, Male: \$20
Cat, Female: \$35
Dog, Male/Female: \$55

Microchip ID \$20

Requirements:

- Must schedule an appointment
- Dogs must be no more than 60 lbs.
- All animals must be no less than 2 months, or more than 6 years
- Dogs must be on leash, and cats in carriers
