



## Sacramento County Water Agency

### WATER CONSERVATION MEASURES

- 1) Residential and commercial locations bearing a street address ending in an **odd number** shall be permitted to irrigate only on **Tuesday, Thursday, and Saturday**, and locations bearing a street address ending in an **even number** shall be permitted to irrigate only on **Wednesday, Friday, and Sunday**. No irrigation is permitted on Mondays.
- 2) Irrigation water shall not be allowed to run off to adjoining property or to the road side ditch or gutter.
- 3) No landscape irrigation shall be permitted between the hours of 12:00 noon and 6:00 p.m.
- 4) Use of water to clean side walks, driveways and patios is not permitted. Washing of streets and commercial parking lots with a hose is not permitted, except to alleviate immediate fire or sanitation hazards.
- 5) Leaking pipes, fixtures, or sprinklers shall be repaired promptly.
- 6) Open hoses are not permitted. Automatic shut-off nozzles are required.
- 7) Restaurants shall serve water to customers only upon specific request.
- 8) All swimming pools, ponds, and fountains shall be equipped with recirculation pumps.
- 9) The County of Sacramento, Water Resources Department, shall assist SCWA customers in implementing water efficient practices.
- 10) The SCWA Engineer shall enforce this water conservation program pursuant to the Sacramento County Code, Title 3 Section 3.40.120. No exceptions to the provisions of this Resolution will be allowed without written authorization from the Agency Engineer.
