



More About Cherry Island

Cherry Island Golf Course is located on 170 acres in Elverta, California at the confluence of the north and south forks of Dry Creek in the northeast area of Sacramento. Cherry Island got its name from the island formed by the two forks of Dry Creek and the grove of cherry trees that grow there. This property, which was previously an underdeveloped floodplain, was purchased by the County of Sacramento in 1986. The golf course includes 22 acres of riparian forests, a heritage of blue oak woodlands, native grasslands, and vernal pools that were restored to their natural conditions. The course was designed by Robert Muir Graves and opened on June 1, 1990. While playing this beautiful golf course, you must navigate along the meandering creeks and five lakes.

The facility includes a fully stacked golf shop, a complete restaurant with full service bar and patio area, and a tournament room available for meetings. The golf course has a driving range, practice putting green and a chipping green. Cherry Island offers a adaptive golf cart for golfers with disabilities and provides training to assist these special customers.

The Golf Shop provides complete golf services that include full service club fitting and club building. Lessons are offered to golfers of all ages and skill levels from a highly qualified teaching staff. Cherry Island Golf Course is an outstanding venue for tournaments of all sizes.

The Cherry Island Golf Shop and the Cherry Island Grill are managed by Empire Golf, Inc. for the County of Sacramento under a Professional Management Services Agreement that includes all Golf Shop and restaurant operations.
