GENERAL RULES OF COUNTY CLEANUP PROJECT

The project must be organized and managed by a *nonprofit civic group* or *community organization*.

The project must include cleanup of public grounds, easements or street right-of-ways as well as vacant lots and private property.

The County must be given a minimum of one week's notice, but preferably more. This notice must be given to the Waste Management and Recycling Division, 9850 Goethe Road, Sacramento, CA. 95827-3561, Phone # (916) 875-6789, FAX # (916) 875-6767.

One specific individual must be designated to represent the sponsoring organization or participating organizations in dealing with the Waste Management and Recycling Division. In certain cases special arrangements may be made, but generally the organization sponsoring the cleanup will provide for disposal at one of the County sites.

Sponsoring organizations will submit in advance a listing of all hauling vehicles participating in cleanup requiring entry at the disposal site. The listing should include vehicle type, size and license number. ***Vehicles not on the list will not be admitted free.*** If it is not possible to obtain the above information on vehicles in advance, some other means of identifying participating vehicles must be arranged in advance.

For youth groups collecting litter along roads, the Public Works Agency may provide a limited number of cones and barricades for protection from traffic. An adult group leader will be responsible for the equipment.

Abandoned automobiles and construction debris will not be accepted free. There is no blanket fee-exempt status.
